Fabrics from the Creative Landscapes collection: Requirements

1. A906 - Creative Landscapes mountains - 1 Panel
2. A908A - Creative landscapes flowers on cream - 1yd - 1m
3. A909B - Leaf texture turquoise - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. A910C - Dotty flowers on black - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. A911B - Two tone floral on heather - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
6. A912C - Creative textures blues and greens - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
7. A911C - Two tone floral on orange - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
8. BB01 - White - $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{4}$ m

Wadding and backing 65" x 65"

**All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.
You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.**

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

Trim the panel to $35\frac{1}{2}$ " x $35\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 2 cut

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $58\frac{1}{2}$ " border 6 top & bottom

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " border 6 sides

8 x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (corners)

From each of the fabrics 3 to 6 you need to cut

16 x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (for blocks)

From fabric 7 cut

2 x 1" x $38\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 2 top & bottom

2 x 1" x $37\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 2 sides

From fabric 8 cut

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 5 top and bottom

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 5 sides

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 3 top & bottom

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $38\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 3 sides

2 x 1½" x 37½" for border 1 top & bottom

2 x 1½" x 35½" for border 1 sides

72 x 3⅜" x 3⅜" cut in half diagonally once for blocks

Blocks



Block diagram



Block divided into four

All the blocks are made in the same way.

Lay out the fabric for the block as in the main diagram. Sew each of the two small triangles together to make a square.

Stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to make the square.

For each colour way you need 4 in total.

Making up the quilt

Sew fabric 7 strip 1½" x 35½" to the sides of the quilt. Next strips 1½" x 37½" to the top and bottom.

Do the same to the next two borders (2 & 3)

Block border 4

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. For the sides stitch 8 block together. Sew to the sides. On the top and bottom add a block to each end and sew to the quilt.

Borders 5 and 6

Stitch border 5 to the quilt as in 1 to 3 and then do the same for border 6 to complete the quilt.

Quilting and binding

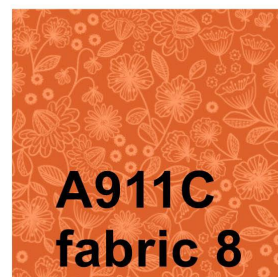
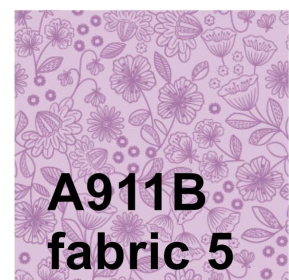
Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 7 for binding the quilt.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

Trim the panel to $35\frac{1}{2}$ " x $35\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 2 cut

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $58\frac{1}{2}$ " border 6 top & bottom

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " border 6 sides

8 x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (corners)

From each of the fabrics 3 to 6 you need to cut

16 x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (for blocks)

From fabric 7 cut

2 x 1" x $38\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 2 top & bottom

2 x 1" x $37\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 2 sides

From fabric 8 cut

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 5 top and bottom

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 5 sides

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 3 top & bottom

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $38\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 3 sides

2 x 1½" x 37½" for border 1 top & bottom

2 x 1½" x 35½" for border 1 sides

72 x 3⅜" x 3⅜" cut in half diagonally once for blocks

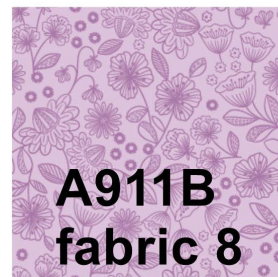

2 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " border 6 sides

8 x 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (corners)

From each of the fabrics 3 to 6 you need to cut

16 x 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (for blocks)

From fabric 7 cut

2 x 1" x 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 2 top & bottom

2 x 1" x 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 2 sides

From fabric 8 cut

2 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 5 top and bottom

2 x 1½" x 50½" for border 5 sides
 2 x 1½" x 40½" for border 3 top & bottom
 2 x 1½" x 38½" for border 3 sides
 2 x 1½" x 37½" for border 1 top & bottom
 2 x 1½" x 35½" for border 1 sides
 72 x 3⅜" x 3⅜" cut in half diagonally once for blocks
