Unfinished block size $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " – border block strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "



Main Diagram

Fabrics from A Winter's Moon collection

Requirements

- 1. BBS12 Dark blue ¾yd ¾m
- 2. BB148 Cream (Pearl) 11/2yd 11/2m
- 3. A947A Winter hare on light silver 3/8yd 40cm
- 4. A948B Twinkling stars on mid-winter blue 5/8yd 60cm
- 5. A949B Frosted foliage on light aqua 5/8yd 60cm
- 6. A950C Frosty ice on mid blue 5/3yd 60cm
- 7. A951B Snowdrops on warm aqua 3/3yd 40cm
- 8. A952B Winters moon stag on mid blue 3/8yd 40cm

Wadding and backing 68" x 68"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

16 x 1½" x 12½" - block 1 16 x 1½" x 10½" - block 1 8 x 1½" x 8½" - block 2 8 x 1½" x 7½" - block 2

From fabric 2 cut

72 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - border 16 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2 16 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2 8 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1 8 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

From fabric 3 cut

8 x 5¹/₂" x 5¹/₂" - block 1 3 x 7¹/₄" x 7¹/₄" cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 4 cut

8 x 2¹/₂" x 8¹/₂" - block 2 8 x 2¹/₂" x 7¹/₂" - block 2 3 x 7¹/₄" x 7¹/₄" cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 5 cut

8 x 2¹/₂" x 10¹/₂" - block 2

 $8 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2 3 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 6 cut

8 x 2¹/₂" x 8¹/₂" - block 1 8 x 2¹/₂" x 7¹/₂" - block 1 3 x 7¹/₄" x 7¹/₄" cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 7 cut

8 x 2¹/₂" x 10¹/₂" - block 1 8 x 2¹/₂" x 8¹/₂" - block 1 3 x 7¹/₄" x 7¹/₄" cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 8 cut

8 x 5½" x 5½" - block 2 3 x 7¼" x 7¼" cut in half diagonally twice – border

Making up the blocks









Both blocks are made up in the same way.

The numbers on the blocks are for sewing and so you will sew from number 1 to 11 as in the diagrams.

Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1. Four of the blocks are made up in one way and then you need to flip the other four blocks as in the main diagram. So, sew a number 2 strip to number 1 square, press. Keep working out until the last strip of number 11. You need eight blocks in total for both blocks.

Making up the center of the quilt

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram and stitch in rows and them sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.

Border - Flying Geese block



Again, sewing by numbers.

Lay out the fabrics for the block. Stitching the long side of the small triangle to the short side of the large triangle. Do the same to the other side. Of each colour way you will end up with twelve blocks of each colour way.

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram. Sixteen for the side and twenty for top and bottom. You need to place some in different ways,

Stitch the sides, press and then the top and bottom to complete the quilt.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Maybe flowers. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

- 2. BB148 Cream (Pearl) 11/2yd 11/2m
- 3. A947B Winter hare on iced aqua 3/8yd 40cm
- 4. A948A Twinkling stars on light silver 5/8yd 60cm
- 5. A949C Frosted foliage on winter skies blue 5% yd 60cm
- 6. A950A Frosty ice on iced grey 5/8yd 60cm
- 7. A951C Snowdrops on twilight blue 3/8yd 40cm
- 8. A952C Winters moon stag on midnight blue ³/₈yd 40cm

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

16 x 1½" x 12½" - block 1 16 x 1½" x 10½" - block 1 8 x 1½" x 8½" - block 2 8 x 1½" x 7½" - block 2

From fabric 2 cut

72 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - border 16 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2 16 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2 8 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1 8 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

From fabric 3 cut

 $8 \times 5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1 3 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 4 cut

8 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2 8 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2 3 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 5 cut

8 x 2¹/₂" x 10¹/₂" - block 2

 $8 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2 3 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 6 cut

8 x 2¹/₂" x 8¹/₂" - block 1 8 x 2¹/₂" x 7¹/₂" - block 1 3 x 7¹/₄" x 7¹/₄" cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 7 cut

8 x 2¹/₂" x 10¹/₂" - block 1 8 x 2¹/₂" x 8¹/₂" - block 1 3 x 7¹/₄" x 7¹/₄" cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 8 cut

8 x 5½" x 5½" - block 2 3 x 7¼" x 7¼" cut in half diagonally twice – border

Making up the blocks



Block 1



Both blocks are made up in the same way.

- 3. A947C Winter hare on midnight blue 3/8yd 40cm
- 4. A948C Twinkling stars on midnight blue 5/8yd 60cm
- 5. A949A Frosted foliage on grey ⁵⁄₈yd 60cm
- 6. A950B Frosty ice on light iced aqua ⁵⁄₈yd 60cm
- 7. A951A Snowdrops on warm grey ³/₈yd 40cm
- 8. A952A Winters moon stag on ice blue 3/8yd 40cm

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

16 x 1½" x 12½" - block 1 16 x 1½" x 10½" - block 1 8 x 1½" x 8½" - block 2 8 x 1½" x 7½" - block 2

From fabric 2 cut

72 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - border 16 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2 16 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2 8 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1 8 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

From fabric 3 cut

 $8 \times 5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1 3 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 4 cut

8 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2 8 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2 3 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 5 cut

8 x 2¹/₂" x 10¹/₂" - block 2

 $8 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2 3 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 6 cut

8 x 2¹/₂" x 8¹/₂" - block 1 8 x 2¹/₂" x 7¹/₂" - block 1 3 x 7¹/₄" x 7¹/₄" cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 7 cut

8 x 2¹/₂" x 10¹/₂" - block 1 8 x 2¹/₂" x 8¹/₂" - block 1 3 x 7¹/₄" x 7¹/₄" cut in half diagonally twice - border

From fabric 8 cut

8 x 5½" x 5½" - block 2 3 x 7¼" x 7¼" cut in half diagonally twice – border
