Fabrics from Jardin D'Automne collection

Requirements

- 1. A926.B Large autumn floral on warm tan Fat 1/4
- 2. A926.A Large autumn floral on light stone Fat 1/4
- 3. A927.A Simple flower on light stone 5/8 yd 60cm
- 4. A927.C Simple flower on dark aubergine 5/8 yd 60cm
- 5. A928.A Autumn butterfly floral on light stone ½yd ½m
- 6. A928.C Autumn butterfly floral on heather 3/4yd 3/4m
- 7. A929.B Floral seeds on rose pink 3/4 yd 40cm
- 8. A929.C Floral seeds on warm natural 3/4 yd 40cm
- 9. A930.B Large floral butterfly on autumnal red 3/4 yd 40cm
- 10. A930.C Large floral butterfly on dark purple 3/8yd 40cm
- 11. BB01 White 21/4 21/4 m

Wadding and backing 70" x 70"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

11 x 4"W x 5½" H (border)

4 x 41/2" x 41/2" (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 2 cut

11 x 4"W x 51/2" H (border)

4 x 4½" x 4½" (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 3 cut

 $4 \times 7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " but in half diagonally twice (block 1)

16 x 31/8" x 31/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

From fabric 4 cut

4 x 71/4" x 71/4" but in half diagonally twice (block 2)

16 x 31/8" x 31/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

From fabric 5 cut

 $8 \times 3\%$ " x 3%" cut in half diagonally once (block 1 & 2)

16 x 1½" x 6½" (block 1 & 2)

16 x 1½" x 4½" (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 6 cut

 $8 \times 3\%$ " x 3%" cut in half diagonally once (block 1 & 2)

16 x 1½" x 6½" (block 1 & 2)

16 x 1½" x 4½" (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 7 cut

24 x 3\%" x 3\%" cut in half diagonally once (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 8 cut

24 x 31/8" x 31/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 9 cut

11 x 4"H x 51/2" W (border)

4 x 4½" x 4½" (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 10 cut

11 x 4"H x 51/2" W (border)

4 x 41/2" x 41/2" (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 11 cut

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom outer border

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " sides outer border

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom inner border

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " sides inner border

 $8 \times 7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " but in half diagonally twice (both blocks)

32 x 31/8" x 31/8" cut in half diagonally once (both blocks)

88 x 11/4" x 51/2" (border blocks)

Making up the blocks

Both blocks are made up in the same way just different fabrics for blocks. Two sets of colour way.

You will make this block up in four quarters.

Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1 as in the main diagram.











4 blocks

with in the larger block. For 1 and 4 of the diagrams you will use different colours.

For diagram 1 you need to sew the short strips to the square on each side. Next stitch the other strips to make the square. Do the same to the other 3. Each square will be a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Flying Geese block diagram 2 and 3. Sew a small triangle on the long side to the short side of the larger triangle. Do the same to the other side. Make up all the Flying Geese blocks. Sew two together as in block diagram to make a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

For diagram 4. Stitch two small triangles together to make a square. Do the same to the other triangles. Next sew in rows and then the rows together to make a square as in block 4 diagram. Size will be $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Lay out all the pieces and stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the block. Make up the other three in the same way.

Making up the center of the quilt.

Lay out the blocks and stitch the top two together and bottom two. Next stitch them together to complete the quilt center.

Inner border.

Sew the strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " to the sides and then sew strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " to the top & bottom.

Middle border.





Sew the strips of $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " to

each side of block. Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram.

10 for the sides and 12 blocks for top & bottom. Stitch to the sides and now the top & bottom.

Outer border.


Stitch the last strips to the quilt sides and then the top and bottom. Your quilt top is complete.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Use your favorite method from fabric 6 to bind the quilt.

Requirements

- 1. A926.A Large autumn floral on light stone Fat 1/4
- 2. A926.C Large autumn floral on warm red Fat 1/4
- 3. A927.B Simple flower on terracotta 5/4 yd 60cm
- 4. A927.A Simple flower on light stone 5/8 yd 60cm
- 5. A928.C Autumn butterfly floral on heather ½yd ½m
- 6. A928.B Autumn butterfly floral on light caramel 3/4yd 3/4m
- 7. A929.A Floral seeds on light stone 3/4 yd 40cm
- 8. A929.C Floral seeds on warm natural 3/8 yd
- 9. A930.A Large floral butterfly on warm gold 3/8yd 40cm
- 10. A930.C Large floral butterfly on dark purple 3/8yd 40cm
- 11. BB01 White 21/4 21/4m

Wadding and backing 70" x 70"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

11 x 4"W x 5½" H (border)

4 x 41/2" x 41/2" (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 2 cut

11 x 4"W x 5½" H (border)

4 x 4½" x 4½" (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 3 cut

4 x 7½" x 7½" but in half diagonally twice (block 1)

16 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

From fabric 4 cut

4 x 71/4" x 71/4" but in half diagonally twice (block 2)

16 x 31/8" x 31/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

From fabric 5 cut

8 x 31/8" x 31/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 1 & 2)

16 x 1½" x 6½" (block 1 & 2)

16 x 1½" x 4½" (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 6 cut

8 x 31/8" x 31/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 1 & 2)

16 x 1½" x 6½" (block 1 & 2)

16 x 1½" x 4½" (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 7 cut

24 x 31/8" x 31/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 8 cut

24 x 31/8" x 31/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 9 cut

11 x 4"H x 5½" W (border)

4 x 41/2" x 41/2" (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 10 cut

11 x 4"H x 51/2" W (border)

4 x 41/2" x 41/2" (block 1 & 2)

From fabric 11 cut

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom outer border

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " sides outer border

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom inner border

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " sides inner border

8 x 71/4" x 71/4" but in half diagonally twice (both blocks)

32 x 31/8" x 31/8" cut in half diagonally once (both blocks)

88 x 11/4" x 51/2" (border blocks)

Making up the blocks

Both blocks are made up in the same way just different fabrics for blocks. Two sets of colour way.


You will make this block up in four quarters.


Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1 as in the main diagram.











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For diagram 1 you need to sew the short strips to the square on each side. Next stitch the other strips to make the square. Do the same to the other 3. Each square will be a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Flying Geese block diagram 2 and 3. Sew a small triangle on the long side to the short side of the larger triangle. Do the same to the other side. Make up all the Flying Geese blocks. Sew two together as in block diagram to make a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

For diagram 4. Stitch two small triangles together to make a square. Do the same to the other triangles. Next sew in rows and then the rows together to make a square as in block 4 diagram. Size will be 6½" x 6½".

Lay out all the pieces and stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the block. Make up the other three in the same way.

Making up the center of the quilt.

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Lay out the blocks and stitch the top two together and bottom two. Next stitch them together to complete the quilt center.

Inner border.

Sew the strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " to the sides and then sew strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " to the top & bottom.

Middle border.





Sew the strips of $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

to each side of block. Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram.

10 for the sides and 12 blocks for top & bottom. Stitch to the sides and now the top & bottom.

Outer border.

Stitch the last strips to the quilt sides and then the top and bottom. Your quilt top is complete.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Use your favorite method from fabric 6 to bind the quilt.



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
