Requirements

1. A964B - Purple cat text on light purple - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
2. A963B - Catnip multi on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. A961A - Book shelves and cats multi - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. A965A - Scattered cats and books on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. A966C - Cat book covers greys - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. A962B - Purple paws - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
7. A964C - Cat text on light grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
8. A963C - Catnip multi on grey - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
9. A961C - Book shelves and cats greys - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
10. A966A - Cat book covers multi - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
11. A962A - Black on white paws - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
12. A965C - Scattered cats and books on dark – fat $\frac{1}{4}$
13. BBS14 - Multi purples - $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd 1.25m
14. BB01 - White - $1\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 1.30m

Wadding and backing 72" x 72"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

10 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From fabric 2 cut

20 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From fabric 3 cut

5 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 4 cut

24 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 5 cut

8 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 6 cut

8 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

From fabric 7 cut

16 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From fabric 8 cut

32 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From fabric 9 cut

8 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 10 cut

4 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 11 cut

4 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

From fabric 12

24 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 13 cut

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $66\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom border

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " sides border

From fabric 14 cut

13 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

74 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

Making up the blocks



Block 1 A

Both blocks are made up in the same way. Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1 A. Start with the corners by sewing the two small triangles together to make a square.



Next part is a Flying Geese block.

Stitch a small triangle to the larger triangle, press and then sew the other one to complete the Flying Geese block. Lay out all the pieces as Block 1 A. Stitch in rows and then the rows together to complete the block.

You need 5 of **block 1 A** in total.

Block 1 B is made up in the same way, but this time you need 8 in total.

Block 2 – Look at the main diagram for the layout of fabrics

Still a Flying Geese block. Again, you with sew the small triangles to the larger triangle one at a time.

Lay out as in the block 2 A diagram. Stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the block. You need 8 in total

Block 2 B is made in the same way just different colours. 4 blocks in total.

Making up the quilt.

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram, pressing the seam in the opposite way each time. This will help when sewing the rows together. Stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.

Border.

Stitch the sides to the quilt, press and then the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

Quilting and binding

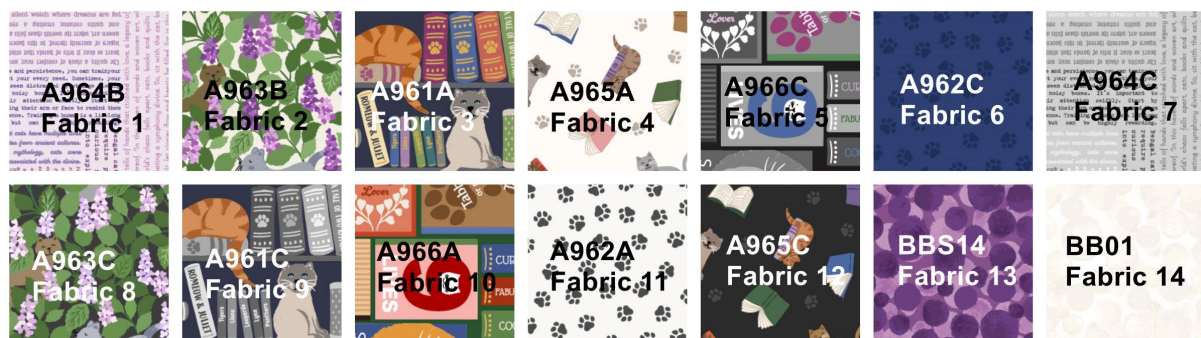
Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Maybe flowers. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 12 for binding the quilt.

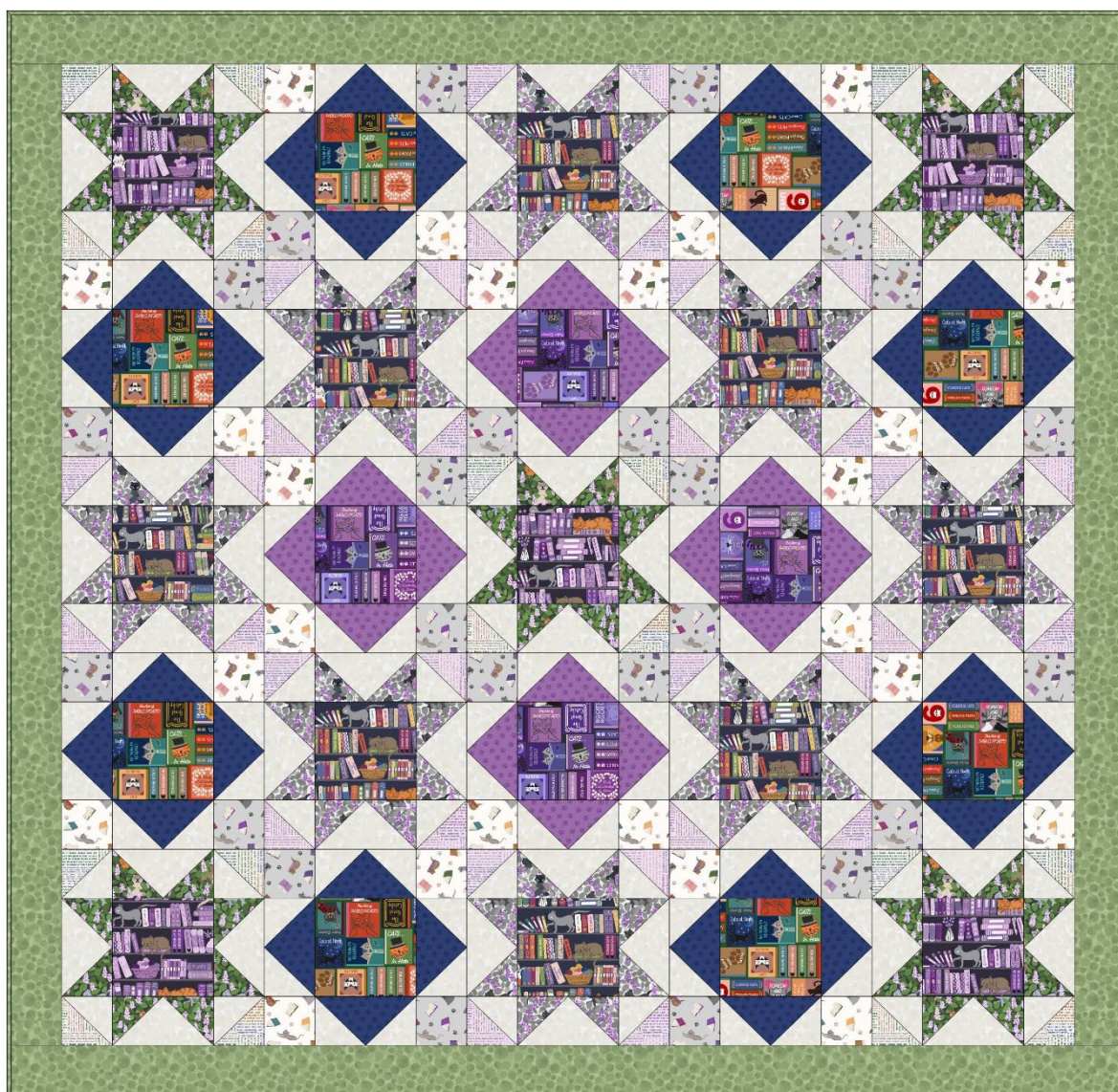

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

10 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From fabric 2 cut

20 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From fabric 3 cut

5 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 4 cut

24 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 5 cut

8 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 6 cut

8 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

From fabric 7 cut

16 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From fabric 8 cut

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4 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 11 cut

4 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

From fabric 12

24 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 13 cut

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $66\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom border

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " sides border

From fabric 14 cut

13 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

74 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

Making up the blocks



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You need 5 of **block 1 A** in total.
