

Throw 1 size 50" x 50" - unfinished block size 9½" x 9½"



Main Diagram

Requirements

Fabrics from Sky Garden collection

1. CC56.1 - Sky Garden Cream - 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ m
2. CC57.2 - Floral Odyssey Light Burnt Sienna - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
3. CC58.3 - Scattered Sprig Taupe - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
4. CC59.3 - Ivy Trail Deep Teal - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. CC60.1 - Wintersweet Pale Peach - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. Background fabric - 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ m

Wadding and background 58" x 58"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

2 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom border
2 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides
20 x 4" x 4"
5 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabrics 2,3,4 and 5 you need to cut

20 x 4" x 4"
5 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the background fabric cut

2 x 1" x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom - inner border
2 x 1" x 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides - inner border
100 x 4" x 4"

Making up the blocks.

Take the 4" x 4" squares of a background and pattern fabric. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the background fabric.

Place the two fabric squares together and stitch a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam each side of the pencil line, press the seam.

Trim back to 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. All the pat blocks will be made up like this.

Lay out in rows and then sew the rows together to make the block



Part of block

You need 5 blocks in total of each colour way.

Making up the throw center.

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram. Stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the throw center.

Inner and outer border.

Sew the side strips to the throw, press. Next add the top and bottom. Do the same to the outer border to complete the throw top.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the throw top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Use your favorite method from fabric 1 to bind the throw.

Throw 2 size 50" x 50" - unfinished block size 9½" x 9½"

Requirements

Fabrics from Sky Garden collection

1. CC56.2 - Sky Garden Pale Taupe - 1¼yd - 1¼m
2. CC57.3 - Floral Odyssey Deep Teal - 40cm
3. CC58.1 - Scattered Sprig Cream - 40cm
4. CC59.2 - Ivy Trail Misty Jade - 40cm
5. CC60.3 - Wintersweet Light Burnt Sienna - 40cm
6. Background fabric - 1½yd - 1½m

Wadding and background 58" x 58"

All measurements include ¼" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

2 x 2½" x 50½" top & bottom border
2 x 2½" x 46½" sides
20 x 4" x 4"
5 x 3½" x 3½"

From each of the fabrics 2,3,4 and 5 you need to cut

5 x 3½" x 3½"
20 x 4" x 4"

From the background fabric cut

2 x 1" x 46½" top & bottom - inner border
2 x 1" x 45½" sides - inner border
100 x 4" x 4"

Making up the blocks.

Take the 4" x 4" squares of a background and pattern fabric. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the background fabric.

Place the two fabric squares together and stitch a ¼" seam each side of the pencil line, press the seam.

Trim back to 3½" x 3½" square. All the pat blocks will be made up like this.

Lay out in rows and then sew the rows together to make the block


Sew the side strips to the throw, press. Next add the top and bottom. Do the same to the outer border to complete the throw top.

Requirements

Fabrics from Sky Garden collection

1. CC56.3 - Sky Garden Green Grey - 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ m
2. CC57.1 - Floral Odyssey Misty Jade - 40cm
3. CC58.2 - Scattered Sprig Pale Peach - 40cm
4. CC59.1 - Ivy Trail Cream - 40cm
5. CC60.2 - Wintersweet Light Burnt Sienna - 40cm
6. Background fabric - 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ m

Wadding and background 58" x 58"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

2 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom border
2 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides
20 x 4" x 4"
5 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

100 x 4" x 4"
