Size of runner 58" x 58" - unfinished block size 2½" x 5½" - 5½" x 5½"



Main Diagram

Fabrics from Animal Alphabet collection

Requirements

1. A967 - Animal Alphabet 1 squares yard panel
2. A970A - Animals on bright pink - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
3. A971A - Animal names on cream - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
4. A972A - Letters on cream - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. A973C - Blue stripes - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. A974C - Patchwork blues - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
7. BB01 - White - $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{4}$ m
8. BB036 - Aegean blue - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd - $\frac{3}{4}$ m

Wadding and backing 65" x 65"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut (cushion panels)

4 x $17\frac{1}{2}$ " x $17\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabric 2, 3, 4 and 5 cut

4 x $6\frac{3}{4}$ " x $6\frac{3}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (you will have 2 over)

8 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (border)

From fabric 6 cut

8 x 4" x 4"

8 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (border)

From fabric 7 cut

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " sides

8 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (border)

4 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

72 x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{8}$ "

From fabric 8 cut

8 x 2" x $17\frac{1}{2}$ " sides

8 x 2" x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom

Making up the blocks

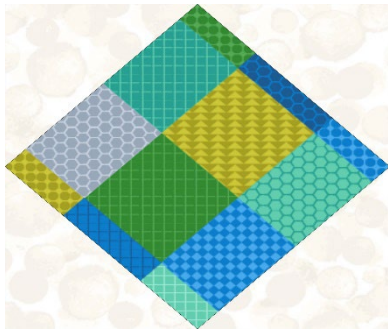
Take the cushion panels the strips of fabric 8.

Stitch the shorter strips to the sides, press and then the top and bottom strips to complete this part.

Next the Flying Geese block



Sew a small triangle on the long side to the small side of the larger triangle, press back. Do the same to the other side. You will have 14 of each colour way.



Diamond in a square. Stitch the opposite triangles to the square. Fold in half on each piece and match the folds pin into place. Sew and do the same to the other two triangles to complete the block. You need 8 blocks in total.

Making up the center of the quilt

This made up in four parts.



Top left



top right



Bottom left

Bottom right

Lay out the flying Geese blocks and corner squares as in the main diagram. Sew the rows together for the sides, press. Next stitch the bottom or top strips to your work. Sew the top and bottom blocks together. Next join the two rows together to complete the center.

Border

Lay out all the fabric pieces for the border. Stitch the side strips together adding the 1½" x 3½" strips to each end. Sew them to the quilt, press back. Do the same to the top and bottom strips, but this time add the strip and squares to each end. To complete the quilt top.

Quilting and binding

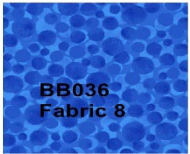
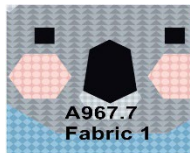
Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 8 for binding the quilt.
