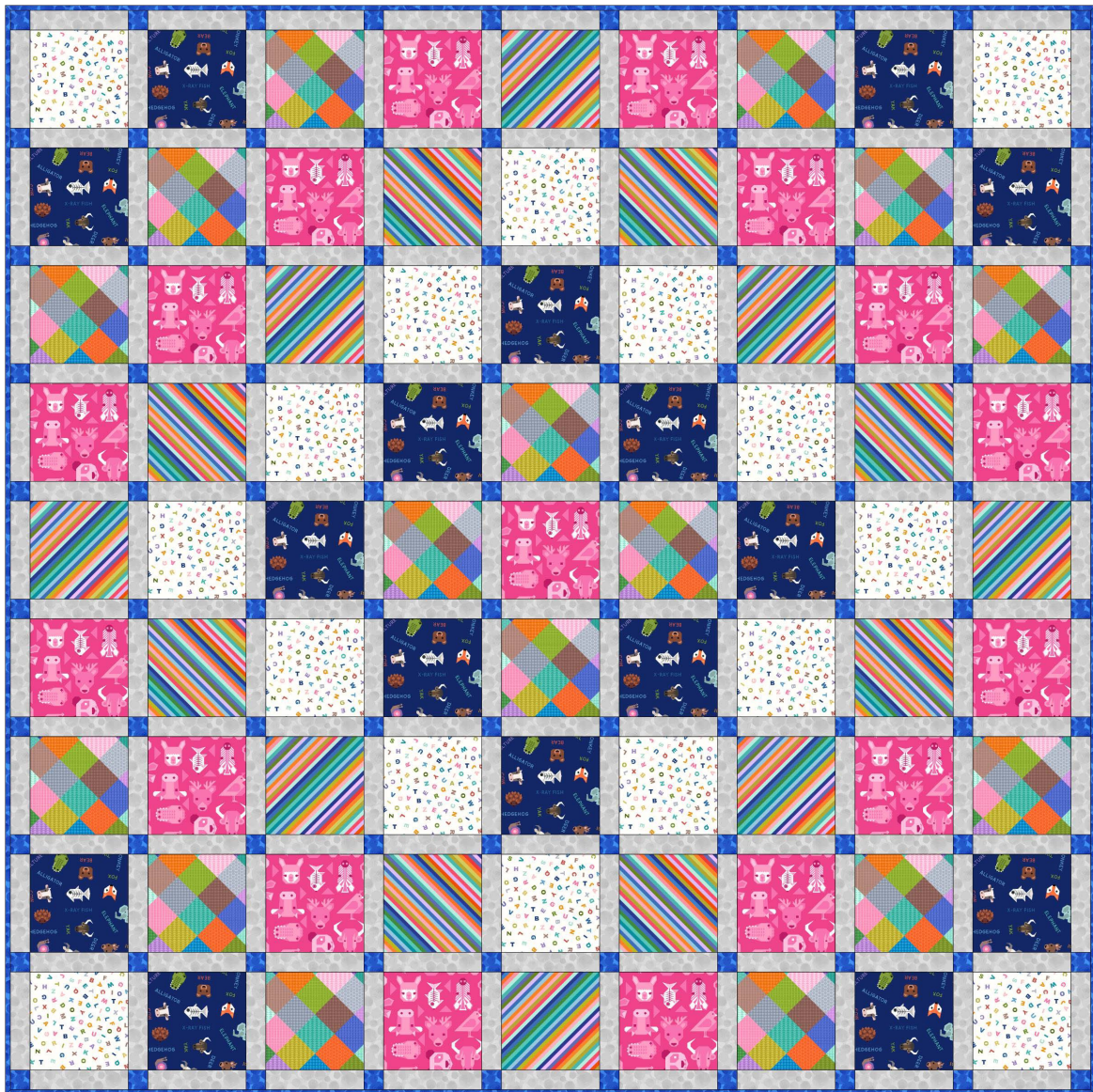

Fabrics from Animal Alphabet collection

Requirements

1. A970A - Animals on bright pink - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 65cm
2. A971C - Animal names on blue - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 65cm
3. A972A - Letters on cream - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 65cm
4. A973A - Multi stripes - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 65cm
5. A974A - Patchwork multi - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 65cm
6. BB036 - Aegean blue - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd – 30cm
7. BB03 - Light grey - $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{2}$ m

Wadding and backing 60" x 60"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

17 x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabrics 2 to 5 you need to cut

16 x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 6 cut

100 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 7 cut

180 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

Making up the quilt

This is a very easy quilt to sew. Work on a row at a time. The top row will be squares and sashing. If you press your seam on each row in the opposite way each time this will help when sewing the rows together.

Next row will be sashing strips and your $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Keep working down the rows and then sew the rows together to complete the quilt top.



Quilting and binding

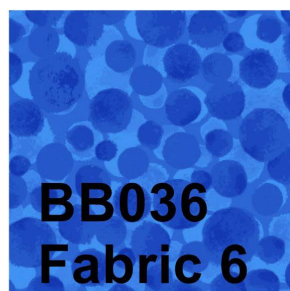
Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

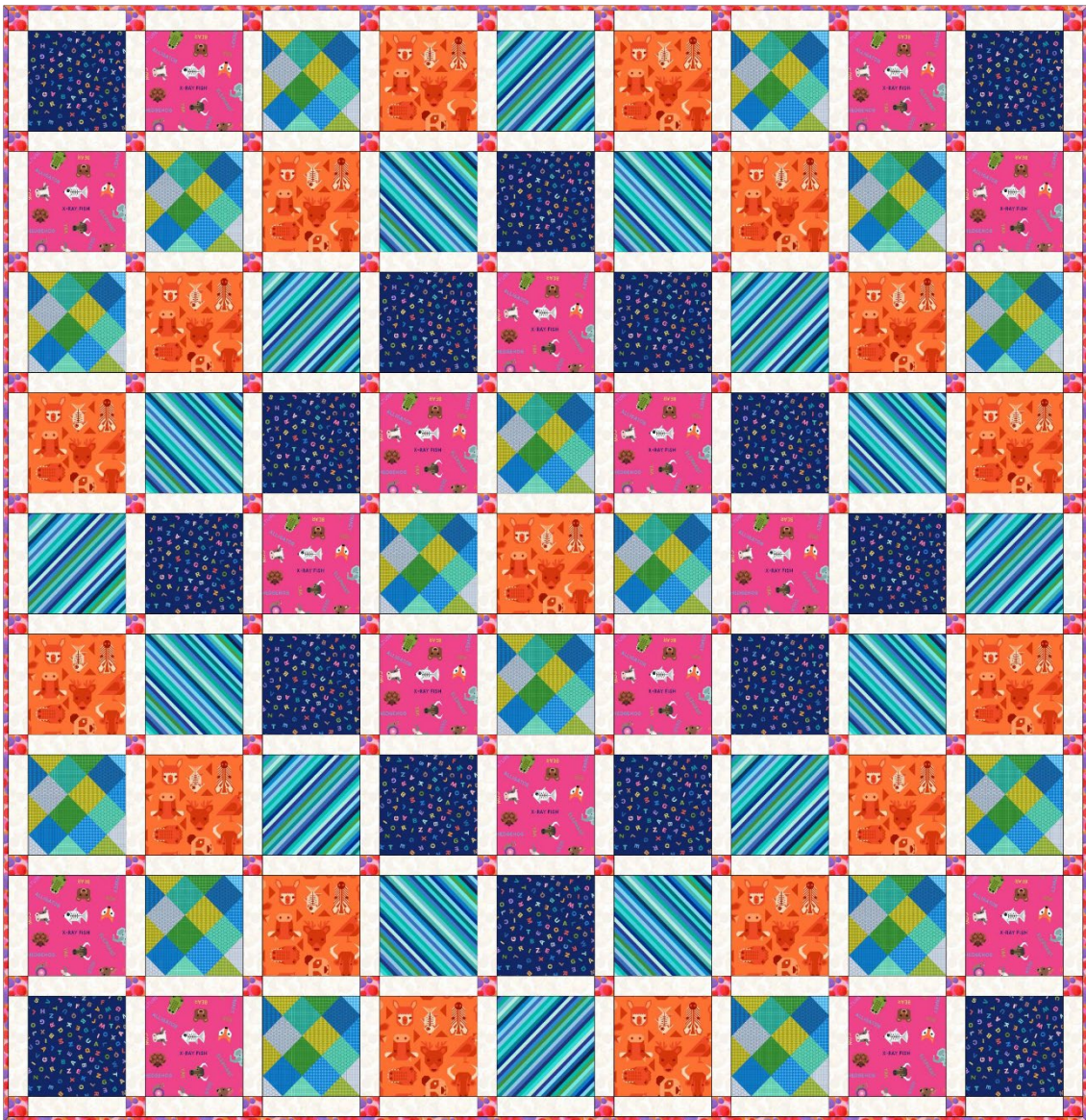
Use your favorite method from fabric 6 for binding the quilt.

3. A972C - Letters on dark blue - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 65cm
4. A973C - Blue stripes - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 65cm
5. A974C - Patchwork blues - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 65cm
6. BB038 - Joyful multi - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd – 30cm
7. BB01 - White - $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{2}$ m

Wadding and backing 60" x 60"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

17 x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabrics 2 to 5 you need to cut

16 x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 6 cut

100 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ "

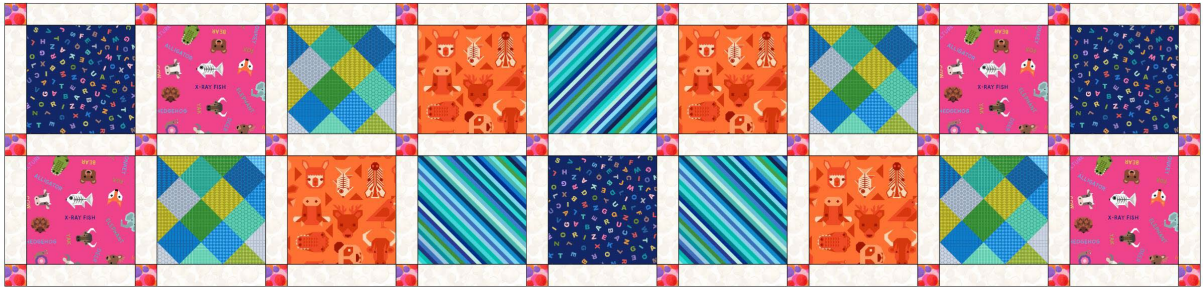
From fabric 7 cut

180 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

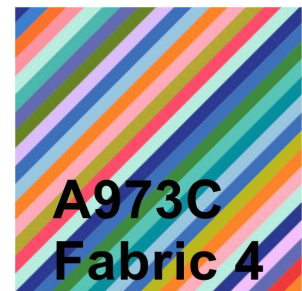
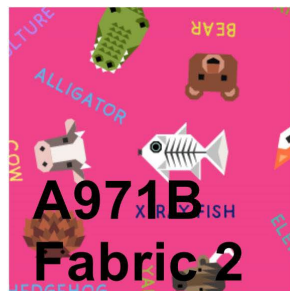

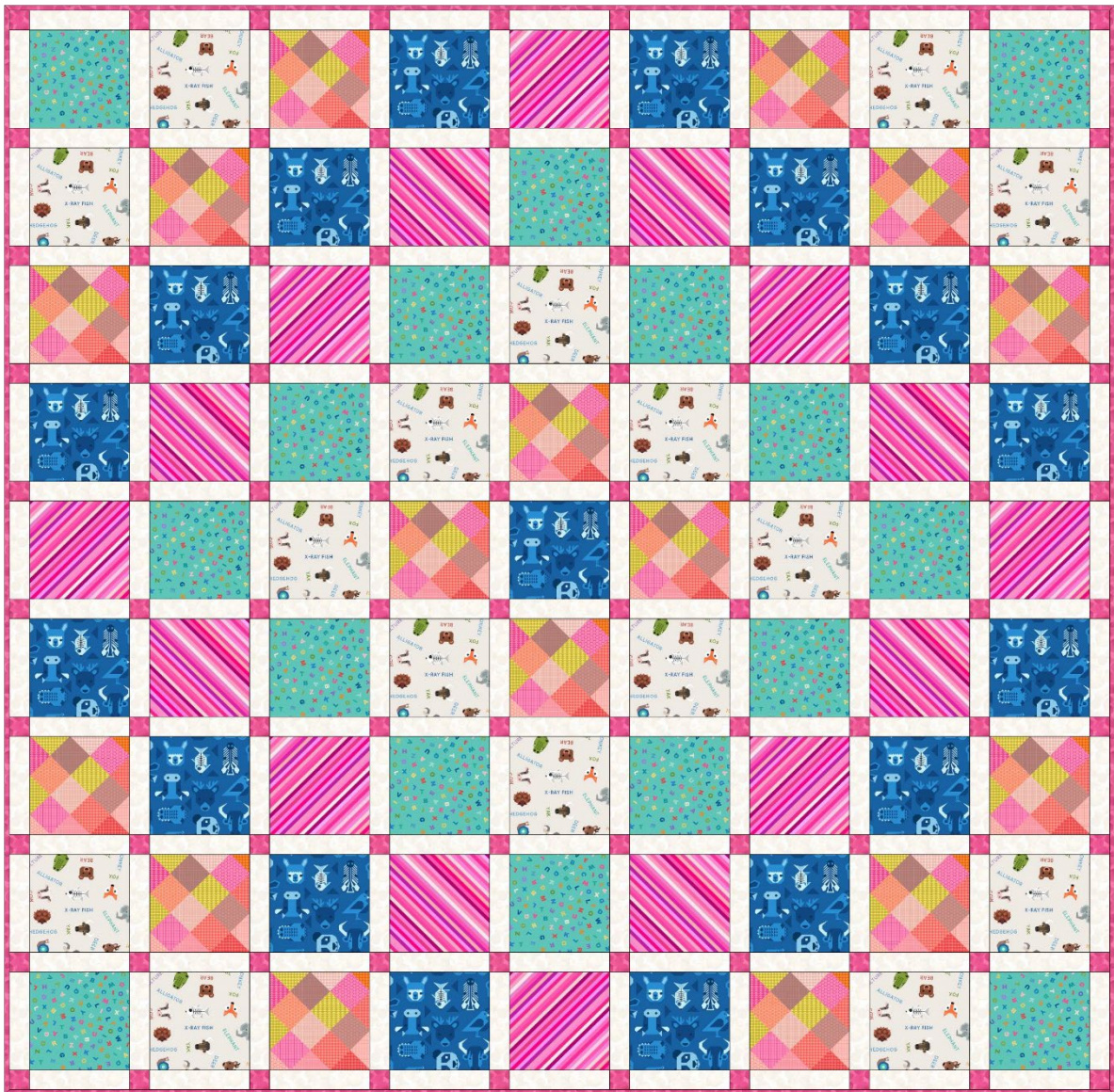

4. A973B - Pink stripes - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 65cm
5. A974B - Patchwork pinks - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 65cm
6. BB015 - Carnival pink - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd – 30cm
7. BB01 - White - $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{2}$ m

Wadding and backing 60" x 60"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

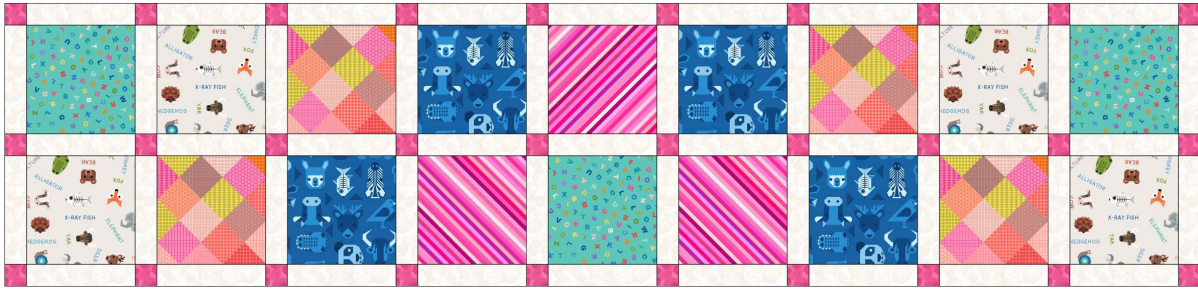
