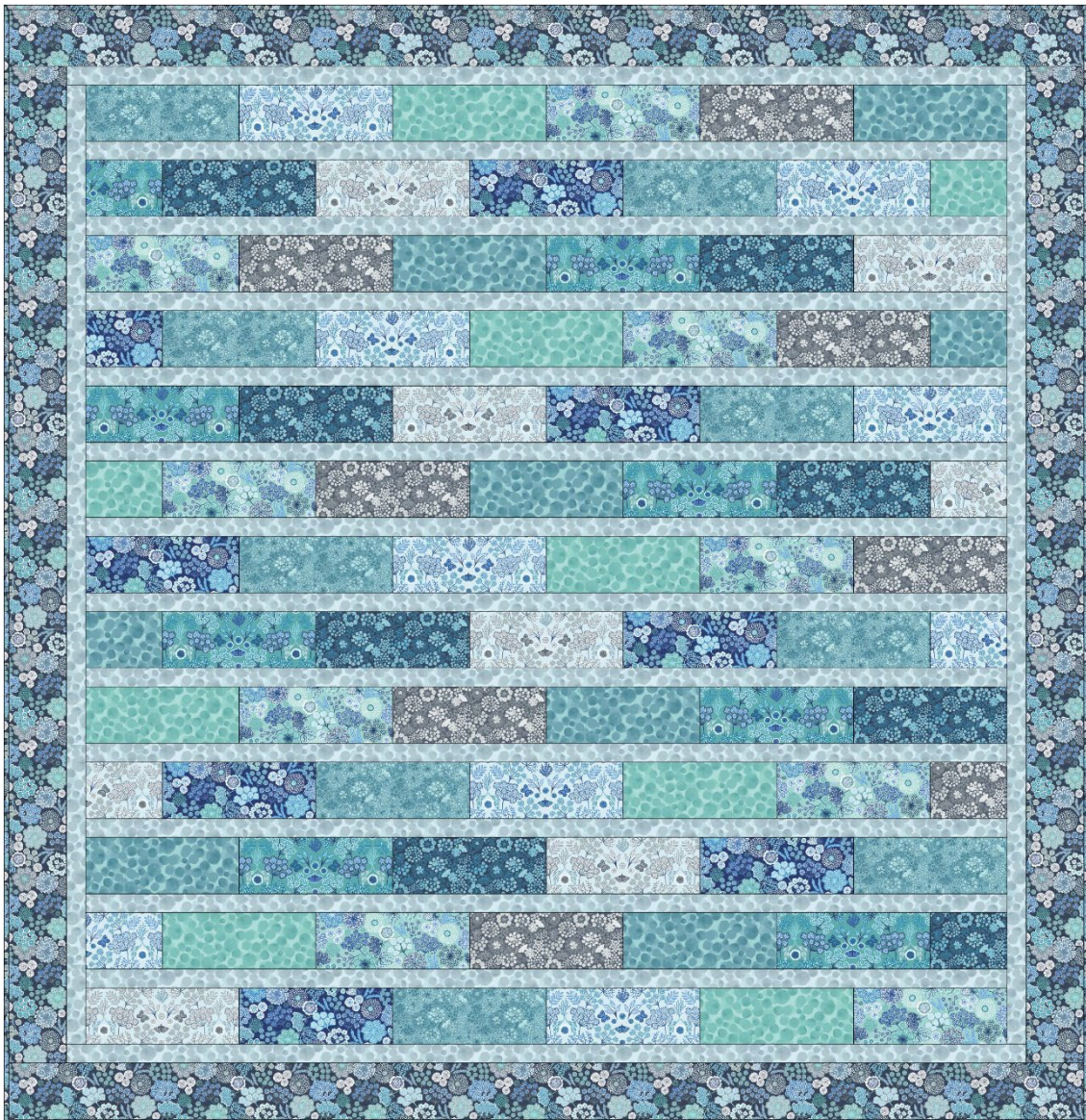

Main Diagram

Fabrics from Jardin D'Hiver Flannels collection

Requirements

1. F926A - Large winter floral on ice - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
2. F926B - Large winter floral on blue - long $\frac{1}{4}$
3. F926C - Large winter floral on dark blue - $1\frac{3}{4}$ yd - $1\frac{3}{4}$ m
4. F928A - Winter butterfly floral on iced blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. F928B - Winter butterfly floral on dark blue - long $\frac{1}{4}$
6. F928C - Winter butterfly floral on grey - long $\frac{1}{4}$
7. F930A - Jardin d'hiver on ice - long $\frac{1}{4}$
8. F930B - Jardin d'hiver on light blue - long $\frac{1}{4}$
9. F930C - Jardin d'hiver on iced blue - long $\frac{1}{4}$
10. BBF09 - Bumbleberries Flannel Icy Blue – $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd – $1\frac{1}{2}$ m
11. BBF10 - Bumbleberries Flannel Polar Blue - long $\frac{1}{4}$
12. BBF11 - Bumbleberries Flannel Frozen Blue - long $\frac{1}{4}$

Wadding and backing 62" x 68"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 and 4 cut

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 9 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabrics 2, 5, 6 and 9 you need to cut

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 7 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "

1 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 3 cut (cut to length of fabric)

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $56\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $53\frac{1}{2}$ " sides

From fabric 7, 8 and 11 you need to cut

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF



Subcut: 6 x 3½" x 8½"

2 x 3½" x 4½"

From fabric 10 cut (cut to length of fabric)

2 x 1½" x 50½" top and bottom

2 x 1½" x 51½" sides

12 x 1½" x 48½" sashing strips

From fabric 12 cut

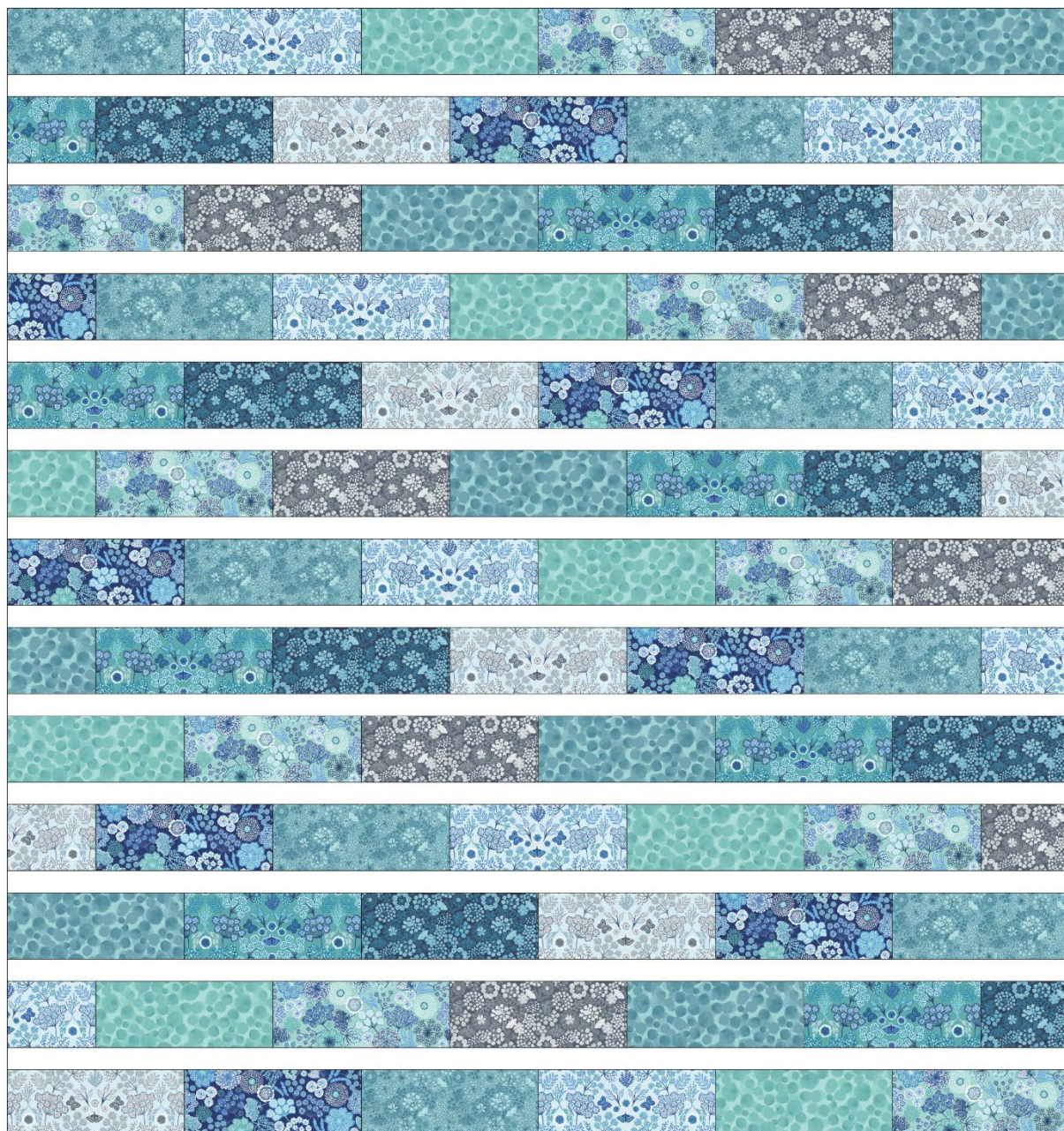
2 x 3½" x WOF

Subcut: 7 x 3½" x 8½"

2 x 3½" x 4½"

Making up the throw

Look at the diagram for lay out of the strips. This has no sashing on the diagram only fabric strips.



Sew each of the rows together, pressing as you go. Next stitch the sashing strips in between each row to complete the throw center.

Add the borders

Stitch the inner border sides and then the top and bottom. Do the same to the outer border to complete the throw.

Quilting and binding

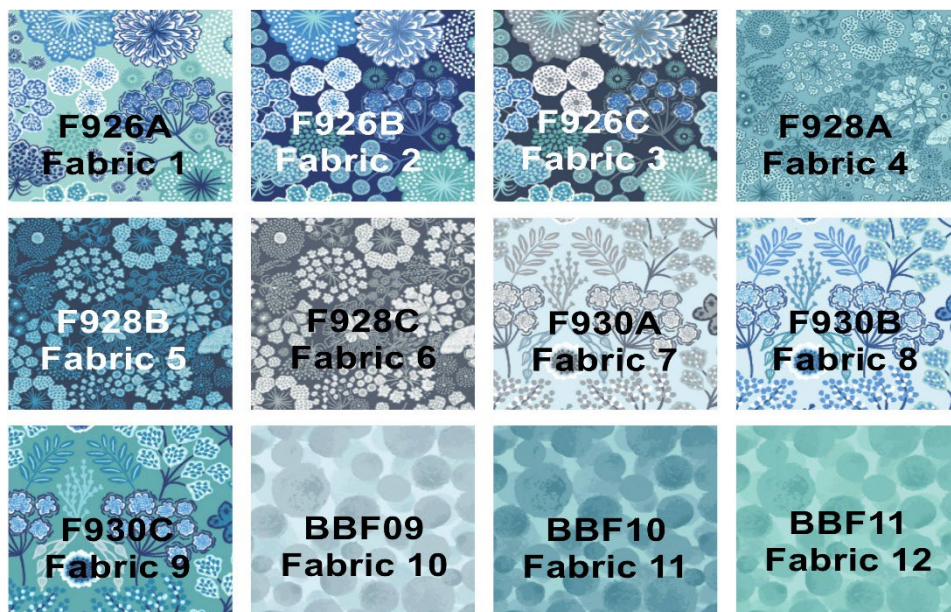
Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 3 for binding the quilt.



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
